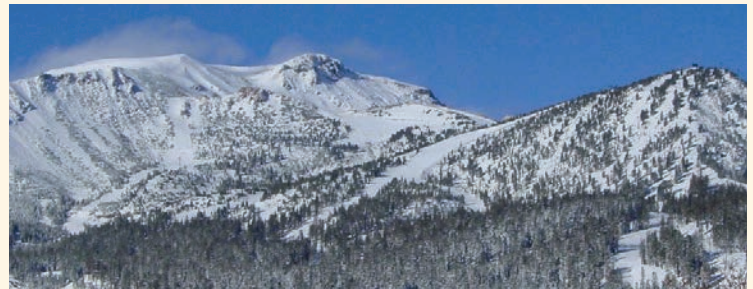

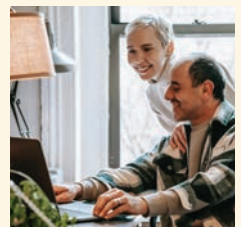

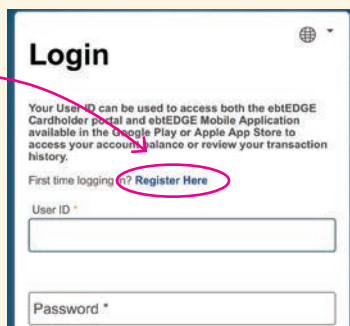

2023 Tax Year State and Federal Credits

2023 Tax Year State and Federal Credits



It's Your Money, You Earned It!

THE STATE AND FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDITS (EITCs) are impactful tax credits for people who work full- or part-time. This means extra cash in your pocket. If you have income from work, you can file your returns and claim your EITC refunds, even if you don't owe any income tax. You can also file amended federal returns for the previous three years and amended state returns for the previous four years, if you did not claim your EITC or Child Tax Credit (CTC) in prior years. There is no late filing penalty if you do not have a tax liability in the prior years.

The EITC refunds are not counted as income when your CalWORKs, CalFresh or Medi-Cal benefits are calculated. Ask your eligibility worker for more details.

CALIFORNIA EITC (CalEITC) requires filing your state tax return (form 540 2EZ or 540) and form FTB 3514. CalEITC is available for working individuals at least 18 years of age or older. The age limit does not apply if the individual has a qualifying child. Tax filers must have lived in California for at least six months of the tax year to qualify. CalEITC eligibility can be claimed by taxpayers who have either a Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number.

FEDERAL EITC requires filing your federal tax return (form 1040EZ, 1040 or 1040A) and the Schedule Earned Income Credit. For 2023, if you don't have a qualifying child, filers must be at least 25 years old, but under 65 years old at the end of the tax year to qualify. The age limit does not apply if you have a qualifying child.

California Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC)

The California Young Child Tax Credit is up to \$1,117 per family for tax year 2023 and adjusted for inflation annually in future years. Families must have at least one qualifying child under 6 years old at the end of the tax year, must file a California state tax return, and meet the requirements of the CalEITC. As of tax year 2022 forward, taxpayers do not need to have earned income to be eligible. However, you must otherwise meet CalEITC and YCTC requirements. Note that taxpayers without at least \$1 of earned income will not qualify for CalEITC.

New Foster Youth Tax Credit (FYTC)

The Foster Youth Tax Credit is available for tax year 2023. You may be eligible for up to \$1,117 in a refundable credit if you meet all of the following criteria: qualify for CalEITC, were age 18 through 25 at end of tax year 2023, were in foster care at age 13 or older and placed through the California foster care system, and satisfy the foster care verification requirement.

Reclame sus créditos estatales y federales de 2022



ES SU DINERO ¡Usted se lo ganó!

LOS CRÉDITOS TRIBUTARIOS POR INGRESOS DEL TRABAJO (EITC) ESTATALES Y FEDERALES son créditos especiales para personas que trabajan a tiempo completo o a tiempo parcial, lo que significa más dinero en su bolsillo. Si tiene ingresos de trabajo, puede presentar sus declaraciones y reclamar sus reembolsos EITC, incluso si no debe impuestos por ingresos. Si no reclamó su EITC o crédito tributario por hijos (CTC) anteriormente, puede presentar declaraciones corregidas para los últimos tres años (declaraciones federales) o cuatro años (declaraciones estatales). No hay sanción por presentar tarde sus declaraciones si no debe impuestos para esos años.

Los reembolsos EITC no cuentan como ingresos a la hora de calcular sus beneficios de CalWORKs, CalFresh o Medi-Cal. Para saber más, hable con su trabajador de elegibilidad.



CALIFORNIA EITC (CalEITC) requiere su declaración de impuestos estatales (formulario 540 2EZ o 540) y el formulario FTB 3514. CalEITC está disponible para personas que trabajan y tienen al menos 18 años de edad. El límite de edad no se aplica si la persona tiene un hijo elegible. Los contribuyentes deben vivir en California durante al menos seis meses del año fiscal actual para calificar. A partir del año fiscal 2020, los contribuyentes que tengan un número de seguro social o un número de identificación de contribuyente individual pueden reclamar la elegibilidad para CalEITC.

FEDERAL EITC requiere la presentación de su declaración de impuestos federales (formulario 1040EZ, 1040 o 1040A) y el Programa de crédito por ingreso del trabajo. Solo para el año fiscal 2022, los contribuyentes deben tener al menos 19 años, pero menos de 65 años al final del año fiscal para calificar. El límite de edad no se aplica si tiene un hijo que califica.

Crédito tributario por hijos pequeños de California

El crédito tributario por hijos pequeños de California (Young Child Tax Credit, YCTC) es de hasta \$1,083 por familia para el año fiscal 2022 y se ajusta anualmente por inflación en años futuros. Las familias deben tener al menos un hijo elegible menor de 6 años al final del año fiscal, deben presentar una declaración de impuestos del estado de California y cumplir con los requisitos de CalEITC, excepto a partir del año fiscal 2022, los contribuyentes no necesitan haber tenido ingresos para ser elegibles. Los contribuyentes sin al menos \$1 de ingresos ganados no calificarían para CalEITC.

Nuevo crédito tributario para jóvenes bajo crianza temporal

El nuevo crédito tributario para jóvenes bajo crianza temporal (New Foster Youth Tax Credit, FYTC) está disponible para el año fiscal 2022. Puede ser elegible para un crédito reembolsable de hasta \$1,083 si reúne todos los siguientes requisitos: calificar para CalEITC, tenía entre 18 a 25 años al final del año fiscal 2022, estuvo bajo crianza temporal a los 13 años o más y fue colocado a través del sistema de cuidado de crianza
