


New Positive Cases per Week


Population Adjusted Case Rate per 100,000




NUMBER OF POSITIVE CASES BY WEEK FOR THE PAST MONTH

HOSPITAL STATUS

- No current COVID-19 related hospitalizations
- No recent hospitalizations in Mono County
- 10/20/2022 1 death COVID (+) but not cause of death

- Status = Green

ACTIVE COVID STRAINS

California: November 2, 2022 for the month of October BA.2.75, **BA.4.6, BA.4**, BF.7, and **BA.5** sublineages (which include BQ.1 and BQ.1.1) make up 2.3%, 4.3%, 0.8%, 4.7%, and 75.8% of confirmed Omicron cases sequenced, respectively.

BIVALENT VACCINE EFFICACY

The term “bivalent” means that they target two strains of COVID-19: **the original strain** that first appeared in the U.S. in early 2020 and the Omicron subvariants **BA. 4 and BA. 5** that emerged more recently in the summer of 2022.
