This law firm represents the United States Board of Water Commissioners and the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner/Water Master for the Walker River ("collectively Water Master"). All waters of the Walker River and its tributaries are under the jurisdiction of the federal district court for the District of Nevada which issued the C-125 decree and appointed the United States Board of Water Commissioners and the Water Master to administer and distribute the waters of the Walker River in the mid to late 1930's.

It is our understanding the proposed Sierra High Project ("Project") is bordered on the west by the Highline Ditch which is a privately owned ditch and a diversion of the Big Slough ditch which is owned and maintained by the Antelope Valley Mutual Water Company. The Highline Ditch is a tributary to the West Walker River. If the proposed Project would jeopardize use of the waters of the Walker River from discharge into the Highline Ditch, the federal district court will need to be informed. The federal court would need to approve any action/project that would jeopardize use of the Walker River water and tributaries.

The Water Master's concerns with the Project are based upon the following statements in the September 28, 2022 – Draft Initial Study & Mitigated Negative Declaration for Sierra High Farms Cannabis Cultivation:

- 1. Page 9: The map incorrectly states that the Highline Ditch is a riparian ditch it is not, it is privately owned. The Applicant does not have a right to use this ditch.
- 2. Page 28, 4.10 a: states: "Stormwater runoff from the site could affect water quality within Highline Ditch, a tributary to the West Walker River", it continues that drainage will be directed through a series of swales into a detention basin and into the Highline Ditch. It then states the long-term cultivation operation has the potential to discharge fertilizers, pesticides and other chemicals to surface waters or groundwater.

The Applicant does not have the right to use the Highline Ditch and if pesticides, fertilizers or other chemicals enter the Walker River, they could potentially get into Topaz Reservoir and affect the water quality of the Reservoir and the waters of the Walker River.

Our concerns were addressed with Mono County Planning Staff who acknowledged the Water Master's concern is the use and dumping of water into Highline Ditch, a tributary of the Walker River, by the Project. Mono County Planning Staff advised the Water Master "In order to assure this does not occur, language may be added to the project description, and/or a mitigation measure may be added, requiring protection of the surface waters including Highline Ditch, and retention of onsite stormwater runoff and wastewaters such that water quality is not negatively impacted." If such a mitigation measure is added or the Project is changed so that there is no surface water runoff or wastewater entering the Highline Ditch, the Water Master's concerns would potentially be addressed.

Our further questions are (1) whether there is periodic water quality testing under the policy of water quality control the Applicant contends will be in place to ensure the Project's operations and its discharge of fertilizers, pesticides and other chemicals do not impact water quality and (2) if there is flooding in the future on the Project site, the Project must still ensure there is no impact to water quality. We do not see these issues addressed in the documents provided to date.
